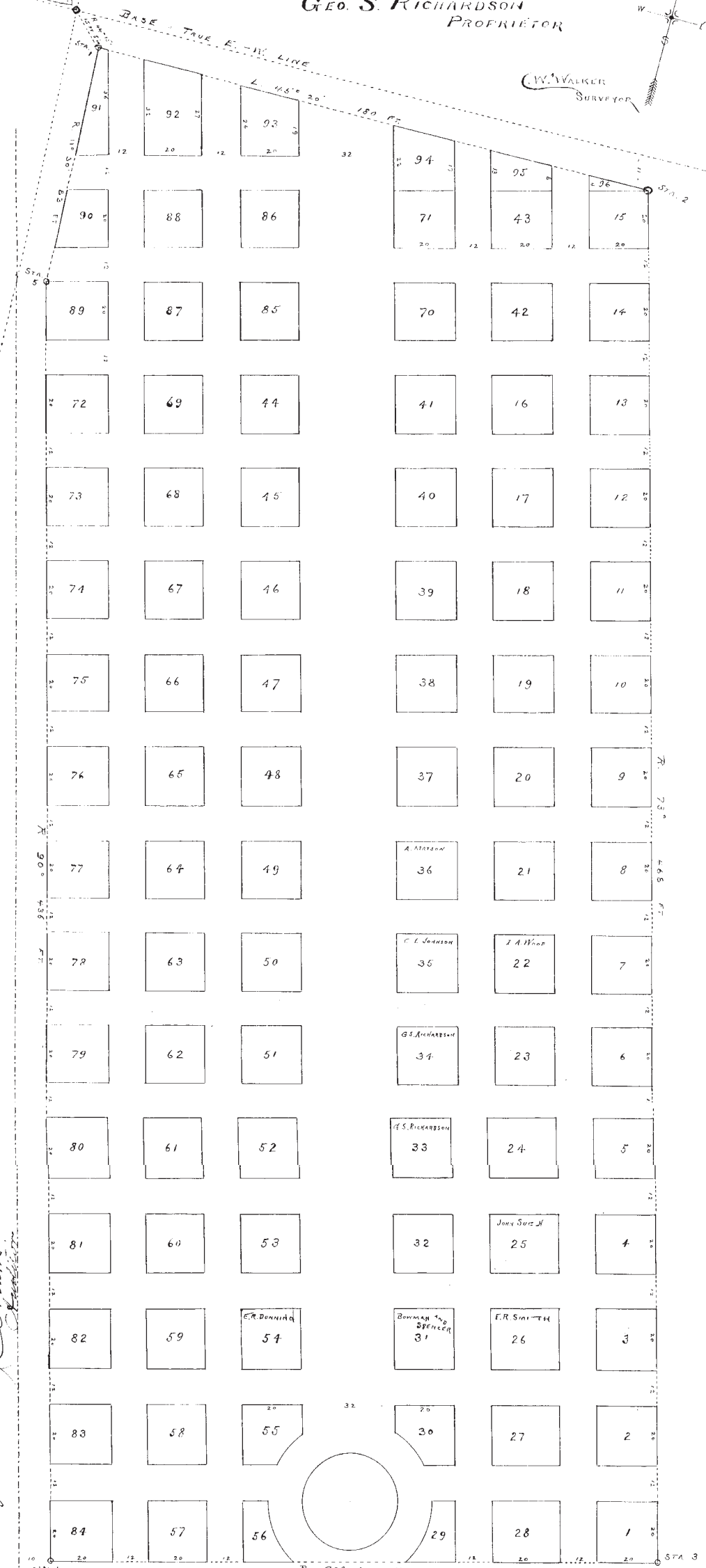

Description: - From the centre of Sec. 14, T. 27 N. R. 2 W., an iron four-inch pipe on a true E-W base; Thence $R 44^{\circ} 15'$, 15 FEET, S to STA 1, the point of beginning; Thence $L 45^{\circ} 20'$, 180 FEET, to STA 2; Thence $R 73^{\circ} 46' 8''$ FEET to STA 3; Thence $R 90^{\circ}$, 200 FEET to STA 4; Thence $R 90^{\circ}$, 436 FEET to STA 5; Thence $R 11^{\circ} 30'$, 83 FEET to point of beginning; Containing 2.41 acres.

We, George S. Richardson & Ellen Richardson, husband and wife, of Jefferson County, State of Washington do hereby lay off into lots, streets and alleys, the certain tract of land above described, in accordance with the above plat, to be known as
QUILCENE CEMETERY
and we do hereby grant, donate and dedicate to the use of the public forever, all the streets and alleys as shown and indicated on said plat
